## United in the Fight Against Terrorism All Party Delegation visit to Latvia (29-31 May, 2025)

In the context of the Government of India's continued fight against terrorism, and a recently launched under Operation Sindoor and in furtherance of India's principled and resolute stand against the menace of terrorism, an All-Party Delegation comprising Members of Parliament and a senior diplomat is undertaking a visit to the Republic of Latvia. The delegation is reaching today on 29 May 2025 and will hold meetings on 30 to 31 May 2025. The visit is part of India's broader outreach with the key international partners, including Latvia, to build an international alliance for cooperation in addressing terrorism.
